RE: LO-ELLEN PARK REMAINS CLOSED TO AND INCLUDING MARCH 5

Dear Parents/Guardians:

In an abundance of caution, all classes for in-person learners at Lo-Ellen Park Secondary School will be delivered remotely to and incuding Friday, March 5, 2021.

Rainbow District School Board continues to work with Public Health to assess the impact of two confirmed cases of COVID-19 at the school, including one which screened positive for a variant of concern. There is also a possible exposure to COVID-19 on one shared bus route.

We recommend that staff and students stay home as much as possible. The variants of concern are highly contagious and we want to limit the spread.

AS A REMINDER:

The following class has been asked to self-isolate to and including March 9, 2021: Grade 8 B Class

Lo-Ellen Park students on the afternoon secondary run on bus Route L809 and the afternoon secondary run on bus Route L881 are required to self-isolate to and including March 9, 2021.

Students on the afternoon secondary run on bus Routes L617 and L620 are required to self-isolate to and including March 9, 2021.

Students on the afternoon secondary run on bus Route NO55 are required to self-isolate to and including March 9, 2021.

Two cohorts are required to self-isolate to and including March 11, 2021: Grade 11 and 12 Physical Education - PAF3O/4O0-02 Grade 10 History - CHC2DI-01

We will continue to monitor the situation and follow the guidance from Public Health. Health and safety, as always, remains our first and foremost priority.
